Senior Ladies: 9 hole qualifiers

England Golf is encouraging clubs to offer 9-hole qualifying competitions. We can do them off our back nine holes. Therefore, this year we have decided that for our Seniors' Salver, when we do nine holes starting on the 10th, players will have the option of counting it as a handicap qualifier.

Whether front or back nine, everyone must sign the sign-up sheet before playing – in all other respects, front nine competitions will be the same as usual. However, for back nine competitions, you must indicate, before playing, whether you want the card to be a qualifier.

For 9-hole competitions there is a new handicap adjustment. Check the calculator in the locker room and use the special nine-hole cards for competitions on the back nine whether or not you want it to be a qualifier. You may have more shots than you think! Qualifying cards must be entered on Masterscoreboard before handing to the competition organiser.

The first back nine competition is scheduled for March 19th. Let's see how it goes.....
